Intense nose with notes of toasty spices, lemons and crisp green apples. On the palate the wine is soft and smooth with vanilla enriching the peachy apple fruit. The finish is bright and refreshing.

Riva Leone Gavi DOCG (Italy)

Delicate with intense fruity and lemony notes. Clean and fresh with a long lingering citrusy finish, this unique wine shows real regional character.

Muscadet Coteaux de la Loire AC Sur Lie Domaine Guindon (Loire)

Aromatic citrus zest and green apple that leap on the nose then a light, racy body with refreshing lemon and mineral flavours.

Andante Gewurztraminer/ Muscat Cave de Ribeauville (Alsace)

- - £24.95

The perfect accompaniment to aromatic Thai food. A blend of Gewurztraminer and Muscat that jumps out of the glass with fresh mango and rosewater aromas along with a hint of spice. Ripe and fresh with a hint tropical fruit and a lemon fresh acidity.

Spy Valley Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)

Characters of gooseberry and asparagus with ripe melon really delicately balanced, deliciously quaffable. A beautiful example of Marlborough's Sauvignon Blanc prowess.

Friendly Gruner Veltliner Laurenz V (Austria)

Austria's wonder grape puts in another star turn, this Friendly GV delivers its customary and bewildering array of delicious flavours; peach, apple, pepper, you name it, this wine's got it! We highly recommend this wine with our range of Thai curries.

Charles Smith Kung Fu Girl Riesling Columbia Valley (Washington)

Another superb match for Thai cuisine. Aromatic, smooth, vibrant and tasty. Great flavours of tangerine, apricot, wet stone, key lime, clove and nectarine.

Bodegas Castro Martín Family Estate Albarino Sobre Lías (Spain)

- - £32.95

A delicious, aromatic Albarino with an abundance of peachy lime zest fruit on the nose. The palate is fresh and vibrant but with more weight and concentration than most examples of the grapes. Jasmine, apricot, lemon, nectarine and lime are all present and correct. This wine from Northern Spain is a firm favourite with the Koh management!

Chablís Domaine Jean Defaix (France)

A very stylish Chablís that has steely elegant flavours of apple and citrus.

Pouilly Fume Les Berthiers Claude Michot (France)

- - £36.95

Dry, refreshing and crisp. Restrained and elegant, it has understated green apple and lime fruit with hints of flint and smoke on the finish.



Red Wine

Alto Bajo Cabernet Sauvignon Valle Central (Chile)

Ripe blackcurrant and plum fruit, with a hint of minty eucalyptus and toasty oak spice.

Intense black fruits with persistent and smooth tannins.

Solarena Barrel-Aged Tempranillo DO Carinena (Spain)

Solarena is ripe in character with spiced raspberry aromas. The enticing brambly fruit on the palate gives way to rounded, velvety, vanilla flavours, while the subtle oak adds extra richness, structure and intensity of flavour.

Valdivieso Merlot (Chile)

Juicy and smooth Merlot. Fruity and jammy with crowd-pleasing red berry and cherry fruit.

The Spee'wah of Murray Darling Deep River Shiraz (Australia)

This Shiraz has a savoury black pepper flavour with a hint of spice and lifted fresh fruit on the finish.

Argento Selección Malbec (Argentina)

This superb Malbec is deep purple in colour and offers powerful aromas of black stone fruit and floral notes. Juicy flavours of plum and blackberry with a touch of chocolate and vanilla from oak ageing which leads into a long lingering finish with ripe velvety tannins.

Pinot Noir de l'Hospitalet IGP d'Oc (France)

Juicy, medium-bodied Pinot Noir with plenty of ripe cherry and wild raspberry fruit with a hint of sweet spice. The tannins framing the fruit are sweet and ripe with a delicious herby, savoury edge to the finish. Soft, elegant and delicious.

Ceppaiano Alle Viole (Italy)

Deep ruby colour. A wonderful nose showing aromas of balsamic, mint and herbs. Creamy mouth feel with gentle acidity, dark fruits, aniseed and orange peel are also present.

Castillo de Clavijo Rioja Reserva (Spain)

The Castillo De Clavijo Rioja Reserva is aged for up to 24 months in French and American oak casks to give this wine real complexity, with ripe mature fruit, lots of spice and vanilla oak flavours.

St Hallett Garden of Eden Shiraz Eden Valley (Australia)

The lifted bright fruit jumps out of the glass, with prominent flavours of raspberry, menthol and pepper spice. The tannins are soft and supple, but firm enough to give the wine great length on the palate. This is a super smooth wine, with a touch of lively acidity.

Chiroubles Clos Les Farges Domaine Cheysson (France)

Bright, violet colour with punnet after punnet of fresh summer berries. Soft and juicy on the palate, a joy to drink.

Bodegas Tomas Cusine Vilosell Costers del Segre (Spain)

Dark red cherry in colour. This modern Spanish wine has a wide aromatic spectrum, with tones of red fruits, raspberries, blueberries, spices like white pepper, clove, cocoa, and aromas of noble wood. Intense and structured in the mouth, with smooth mineral slate tones, liquorice, ink and sweet round tannins. A long and persistent wine with refined oak at the beginning, before a final sweet fruit explosion. This is an incredible and perplexing wine, a must try!

Boom Boom! Smooth, firm, fresh and dark. Dense purple with meaty dark fruit, Asian five spice and sweet tobacco. A firm Koh favourite!

Cocktails

All cocktails £6.95

Here at Koh we're proud of every concoction we serve, and just like our cuisine we appreciate that any drink we serve will only taste as good as the ingredients that go into it and the way those flavours are blended together. We only use premium ingredients, the freshest fruit and garnishes combined in recipes which have stood the test of time along with a few of our own favourites.

Cosmopolitan

Popular worldwide since its conception in 1985, this "so pretty in pink" creation is made with premium citrus vodka, Cointreau, cranberry juice and fresh lime for a perfectly balanced but sharp taste.

Caprioska (or Caipirinha)

Short, strong and cold. These drinks ask for little but deliver a lot, choose between Smirnoff Black vodka or Cachaça 51, then served with muddled limes, a pinch of sugar, served over crushed ice; it doesn't get any more refreshing than this.

Koh Royale

Our own take on the original, we add a hint of both Chambord raspberry liquor and lychee to a flute of our house champagne.

The Martini

A good Martini should be an artful balance of ingredients; crystal clear, biting cold and makes you smile with every sip. We make ours to a classic formula using Tanqueray gin and either dry or sweet vermouth, depending on your taste. If you would prefer yours made with vodka, ask us for a Vodka Martini instead!

Triple Chocolate Martini

The name probably says it all, this is a creamy and indulgent meeting of the finest milk, white and dark chocolate liquors we could get hold of, a good glug of vanilla vodka and topped off with freshly shaved Madagascar chocolate. A superb way to round off a meal instead of a dessert, please enquire about tiramisu and chocolate orange versions of this cocktail.

Koh Samuí Cooler

If all you want is a deliciously long drink that bursts with sun-kissed fruits, then read no further! A special house blend of fruit liqueurs and juices blended with Smirnoff Black vodka makes this long refresher an ideal drink to accompany our cuisine.

Sidecar

One of our favourite cocktails here at Koh, the old sidecar formula has been largely been replaced by faster and cheaper recipes, much to the detriment of its popularity. Remy Martin VSOP and Cointreau work seamlessly together and a squeeze of fresh lemon balances the sweetness to produce a drink of velvety smoothness.

Margarita

The most popular cocktail in the world, and for good reason, the Margarita is an excellent drink that cries out for the best tequila, again to a traditional recipe with the finest orange liquor and fresh lime juice. We also like to show ours a tiny touch of Grand Marnier for depth and interest.

Aviation

So-called because of its sky blue colour, this cocktail makes full use of Tanqueray gin, crème de violette and maraschino liqueurs, to produce another delicious, if somewhat unusual classic that dates back nearly a century.

Berry Good Indeed

Berries with a kick, this extremely fruity number is a smash of mixed summer fruits, Chambournd, Stolichnaya rasperry, fraise des bois and cranberry juice, this is one of our house favourites.

Pina Kahlada

Creamy dreamin'. This is a long cool cocktail made to our own recipe of light and white rums, lime, pineapple and lots of icy Thai coconut cream. The national drink of Puerto Rico, this one works with spicy Thai food excellently.
